




# Interregional cooperation projects



## What about the future?

- December 2019: first Programming Committee (PC) meeting
- February 2021: PC approved draft Cooperation Programme
- March to April 2021: public consultation
- Spring & summer 2021: final approval by Partner States
- Approval by EC expected early 2022
- First semester 2022: first call launched



## No revolution...but evolution

# Key features remain:

- 1. Pan-European
- 2. Similar overall objective
- Regional development policy makers = core target group
- 3. Similar means to achieve the objective
- Main focus on capacity building
- 1. Focus on Structural Funds lightened

### **Evolution:**

- 2. Learning by doing: pilot actions
- 3. Only one single priority in the programme
- 4. Better reflect the core nature of the programme (capacity building)
