
Piemonte Region





- About 4.5 M of inhabitants. The capital city (Torino) has less than 900.000 inhabitants
- Piemonte is the 5th Italian Region in terms of GDP (140G€/y)
- The economy is based on tertiary sector. Main industrial sectors are: mechanical, avio, ICT, agro-food industry.
- 43% of the territory is mountain area
- Administrative fragmaentation: 8
 Provinces and about 1.200
 Municipalities









Final Energy Consumption in Piemonte










Final Energy Consumption in Piemonte






Final Energy Consumption in 2018















Electricity demand and domestic production























Monitoring RES targets in the Regional Energy Plan


























Daily peak load for electricity in Torino City. 2020 compared with 2019 – Source: Ireti SpA





Action Plan




- Boost the territorial coordination with municipalities and stakeholders (boost the Covenant of Mayor Network, roll out the Project Development Assistance capacity, support energy management actions)
- 2. Energy Observatory System, providing access in open data format for most of available energy data
- 3. Support investments in RES and EE by providing grants, financial incentives and technical support to end users
- 4. Support the creation of Energy Communities with legal, technical and financial support
- Create the condition for promoting the installation of additional RES power
- Promote the rational development of energy networks (gas, electricity and district heating)
