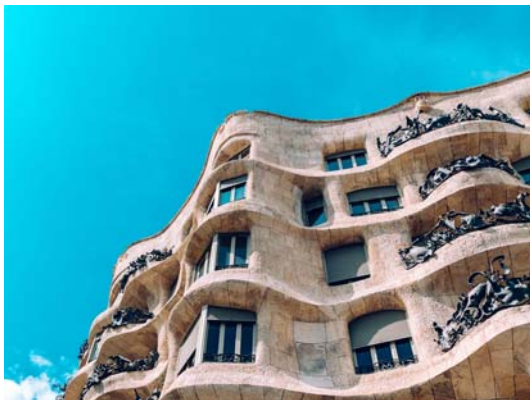
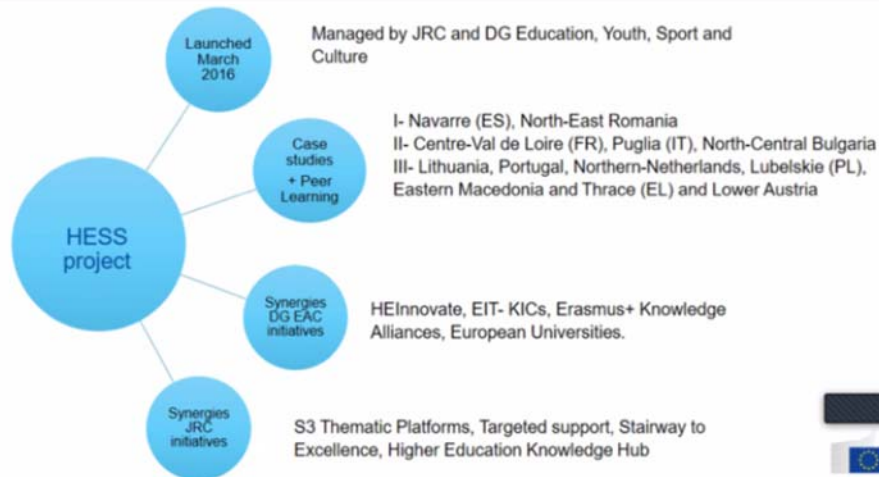
Partner meeting and peer review in Finland

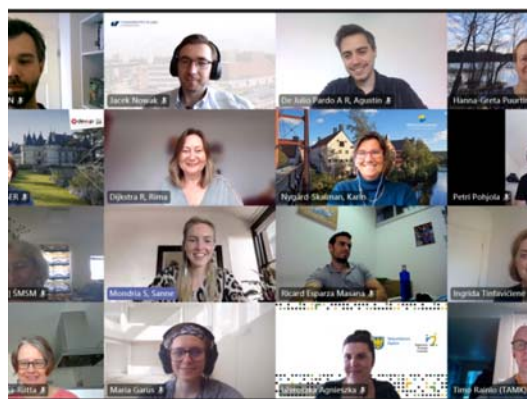
Silesian Voivodship Regional Innovation Strategy
