eBussed on the way towards low-carbon mobility

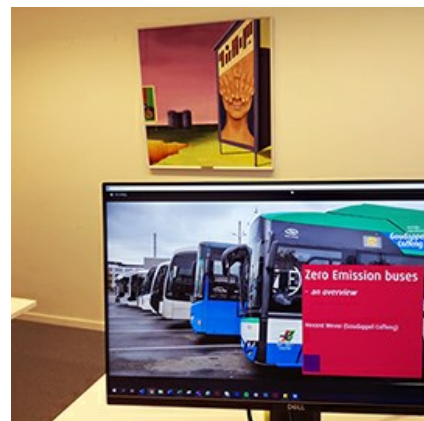
During the spring, the eBussed project has been busy in gathering and sharing information. The first produced articles can be read in this newsletters, and more will follow.
