Project progress and next steps

RESINDUSTRY project continues its advances thanks to the intense work developed by the partners. In the fourth semester, **the Consortium has celebrated several Local Stakeholder Meetings** for defining the Key Performance Indicators, and the first steps for the Action Plans.

Project partners are finishing their Regional Assessments in cooperation with the Expert. The final version will be delivered by the end of June 2021.

Finally, **Phase 1 of the RESINDUSTRY project has been lengthened for 6 more months**, which means the work plan of the period has been extended until the 31st of July 2022. That will provide more time to achieve the foreseen objectives and to address relevant challenges and events that were delayed due to the COVID-19 pandemic.



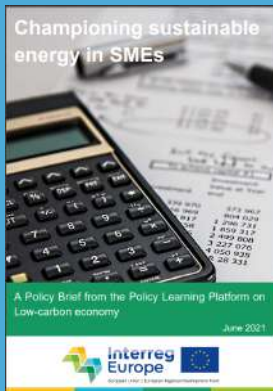
Estonia is turning its economic model to a **more circular and sustainable national strategy** to achieve the objectives that will drive the European investments in 2021-2027.
