

## The expected impacts of the Implementation of the Regional Operational Programme are:

- ✓ Support of more than 370 SMEs and creation of some 860 employment positions;
- ✓ Cooperation of 300 enterprises with research institutes, promotion of innovation and ICT and start-ups creation;
- ✓ Reduce CO₂ blueprint of public buildings by 9,000 tons, produce 36,000 tons/year of geothermy and add 10,000 tons of waste in the recycling process;
- ✓ Increase by 2,000/year expected visitors in the region and construct or upgrade 80km of roads;
- ✓ Cover 250,000 additional inhabitants with improved healthcare services and increase capacity of supported childcare or education infrastructure by 4,000 people;
- ✓ Support some 55 social enterprises and benefit some 5,000 disadvantaged persons with health and social care services;
- ✓ Promote Roma integration through Integrated Territorial Investments.

Based on the procedures of implementation of the EU structural funds, the main source of funding for the implementation period, is the ROP 2014-2020 of the Region of East Macedonia and Thrace.

CHERISH lessons learned, experience exchanged, and consultation with the Stakeholders of the Municipality of Kavala, inspired the context of the selected set of actions, which are expected to contribute to the objectives of the project and the addressed Policy Instrument in terms of new Jobs and conservation and highlighting of the cultural heritage of the fisheries' communities.

#### **ACTION 1:**

Name of the action: Creation of News Jobs and New Very Small Enterprises

#### 1. Relevance to the project

The suggested action 1 is the output of the inspiration of good practices that were presented during the project implementation. More specifically, the sources of inspiration were the following good practices:

(1) Fundo de Compensação Salarial dos Profissionais da Pesca (FCSPP) - Wage Compensation Fund for Fisheries Professionals (Good Practice)

and the consultation with the stakeholders of the Municipality of Kavala

#### 2. Nature of the action

The action will focus on (a) the creation of new job positions in existing businesses and (b) the support for the creation of new very small enterprises (self-employment, cooperatives, etc.) for unemployed.

CHERISH influences the Policy Instrument to include business NACE codes related to culture/cultural heritage of fishery communities, which were not included during its preparation of the respective Call.

The influence of the selected action (1) of the CHERISH project intervention on the addressed Policy Instrument, was carefully designed in order to be in compliance with the general eligibility rules, i.e. not to conflict with the EMFF and Fisheries CLLD Funding Instruments<sup>1</sup>.

The action will focus on creation of opportunities for development of supplementary activities to increase the family income of the fishermen in the lagoon-fishing areas and other fishery communities (fishing tourism, promotion of cultural heritage and tourism, birdwatching in lagoons, cultural routes / info-points and guides, etc.).

- (2) Lamprey catching and cooking From a long tradition to an internationally recognized brand for attracting tourists (LV) (Good Practice);
- (3) Fishing Tourism in Cyprus: an alternative way to learn traditional fishing culture (CY) (Good Practice);
- (4) Pericles project, presented during TEK workshop and stakeholders' meeting (ongoing Horizon2020 project / Fisheries Research Institute).
- (5) CHERISH TEK<sup>2</sup> (Kavala): Traditional Ecological Knowledge of the lagoon fisheries in the Region.

That will motivate young adults to consider staying and creating in the rural area and continue the traditions of the fishing communities, while they will have the means to gain sufficient income for their families.

As concluded during the Stakeholders' Group meetings, for the conservation and highlighting of the cultural heritage of the fisheries' communities, it is a prerequisite to have young people living in the area with decent income from their activities.
