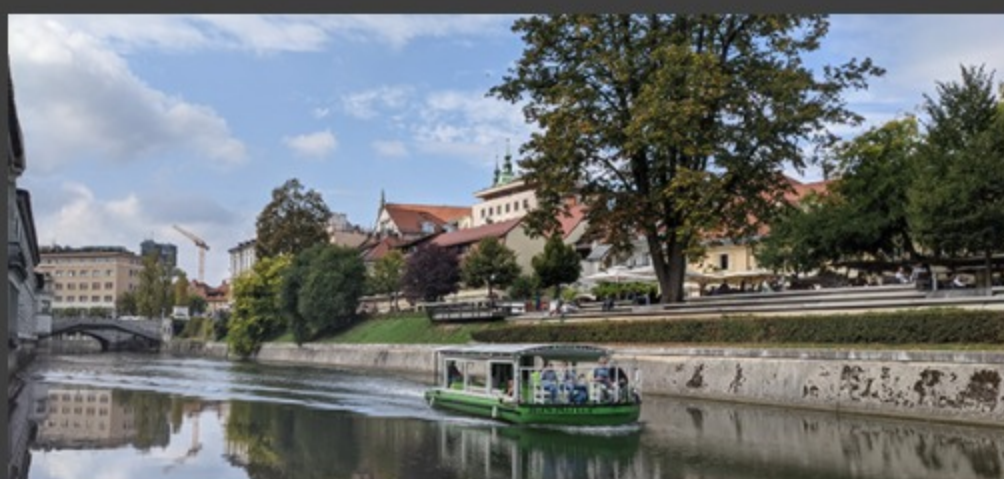




NEWS FROM RIVERSIDE CITIES NETWORK

The **first phase of the STAR Cities project**, dedicated to the exchange of good practices between partners, **is coming to an end**. A lot has been achieved during this 3-year chapter : **the outcome of this cooperation**, advocating for a better management of river tourism in Riverside Cities, **will be presented during an online European conference on November 26**. The event will be hosted by our partner, **NECSTour**.
