## Stakeholders meetings

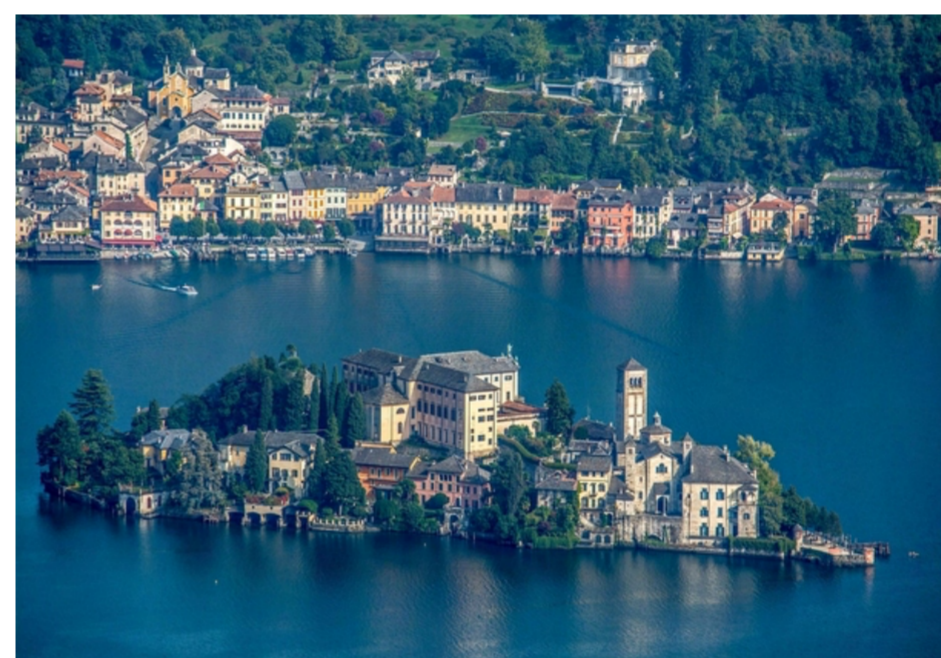

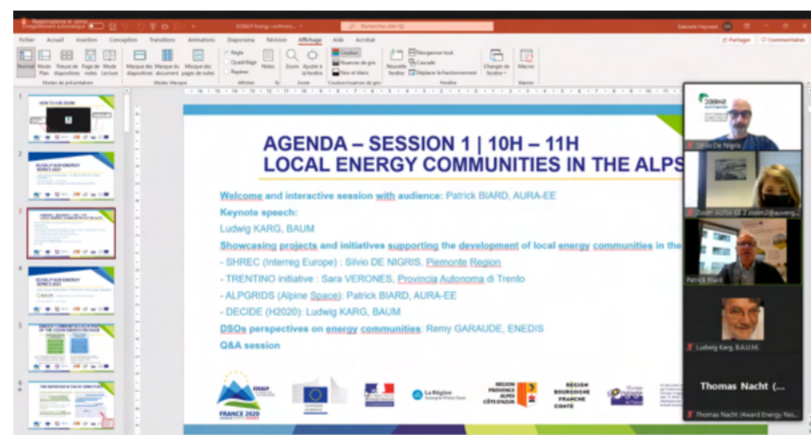

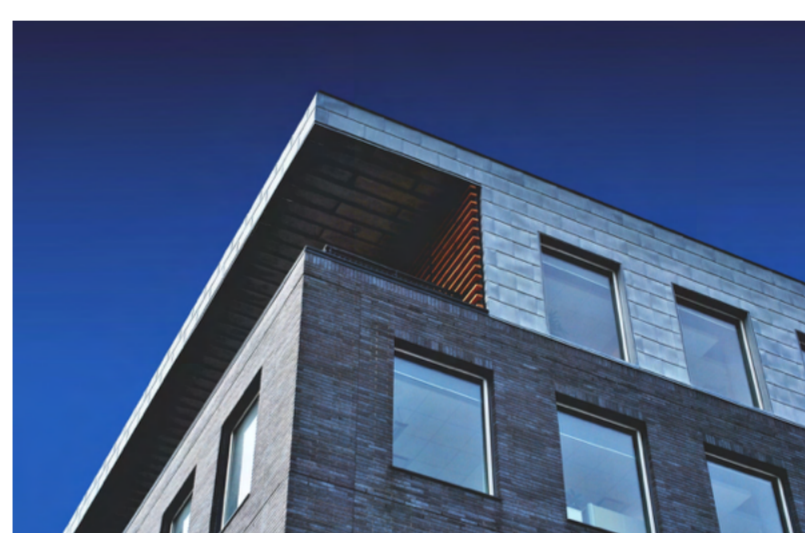
## The transition towards renewable energy

**A citizen wood heating network in Varcès (Isère)**

In January 2021, the municipality of Varcès (8,300 inhabitants) commissioned its wood-fired heating network to supply its public buildings. This system reduces the emission of 295 tons of CO<sup>2</sup> per year (the equivalent of 1.5 million km driven by car).

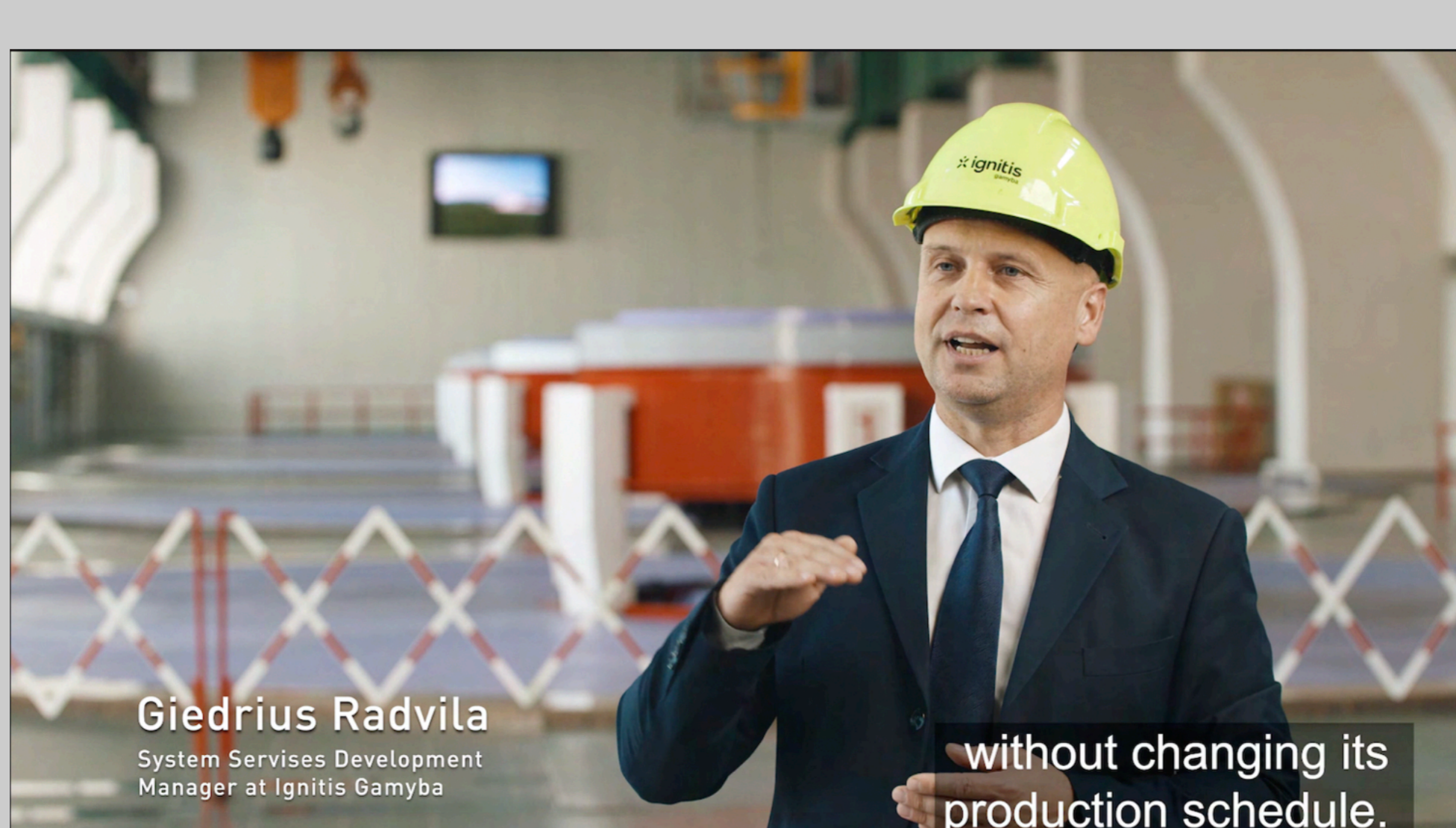
