Brief Historical Background	<p>The bastion represents the southeast corner of the medieval fortress built since the 15th century (it is already mentioned in 1475). Between 1627-1629, during the reign of Prince Gabriel Bethlen, the bastion was rebuilt, reaching its current form.</p>

Current Status	<p>As one of the best examples of revitalizing the built heritage, the bastion today hosts the Center for Urban Culture, many cultural events taking place here. The rehabilitation of this objective was financed in 2009 by the Cluj-Napoca Municipality.</p>
Recent projects implemented	<p>Latest renovation activities took place between 1956-1957, 1959 and 2007-2009.</p>
Projects under implementation or planned to be implemented	<p>It is permanently used for cultural activities such as exhibitions, conferences, cultural activities, hosted by the Center for Urban Culture.</p>
