Measures to be financed under Programme Environment 2021 - 2027

- Models for optimisation of the municipal household waste management systems and pilot tests of the models in three regions
- Raising awareness of practices and behavior in relation to sustainable consumption, circular economy, waste monitoring as well as information and awareness campaigns for stakeholders and the public;
- Completion of regional infrastructure for municipal waste management for municipalities according to the NWMP 2014-2020, whose grant contracts under OPE 2014-2020 were terminated due to unstarted activities.

Requirements for municipal waste management programs

Art. 52
WMA

The mayor of a municipality develops and implements a waste management program for the territory of the respective municipality. The program is an integral part of the municipal environmental program.

It is developed and adopted for a period that should coincide with the period of operation of the NWMP

It is updated in case of change in the factual and / or normative conditions

The program is developed in accordance with the structure, goals and projections of the NWMP

The program includes the necessary measures for fulfillment of the obligations of the mayor of the municipality and the requirements under Chapter Two, Section III of the WMA.

The mayors of two or more municipalities included in a region under Art. 49, para. 9, may develop a common waste management program, in case the obligations, responsibilities and measures affecting the individual municipalities are clearly differentiated in the program

Requirements for municipal waste management programs

The waste management program is published on the website of the respective municipality in order to ensure public access

The program is adopted by the municipal council of the respective municipality, which controls its implementation

The mayor of the municipality provides information on an annual base latest by March 31 to the municipal council about the implementation of the program in the previous calendar year

The Minister of Environment and Water issues instructions on the development of municipal programs
