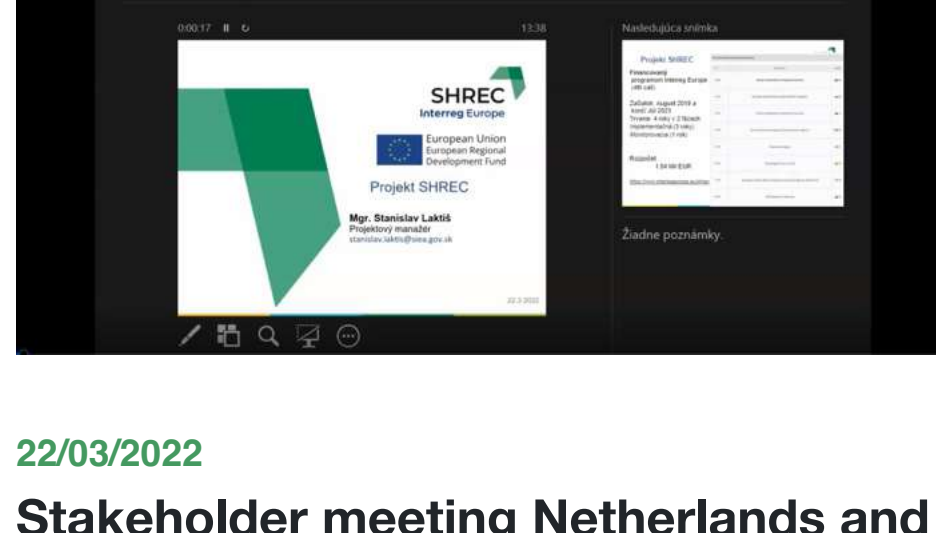
Stakeholders meetings

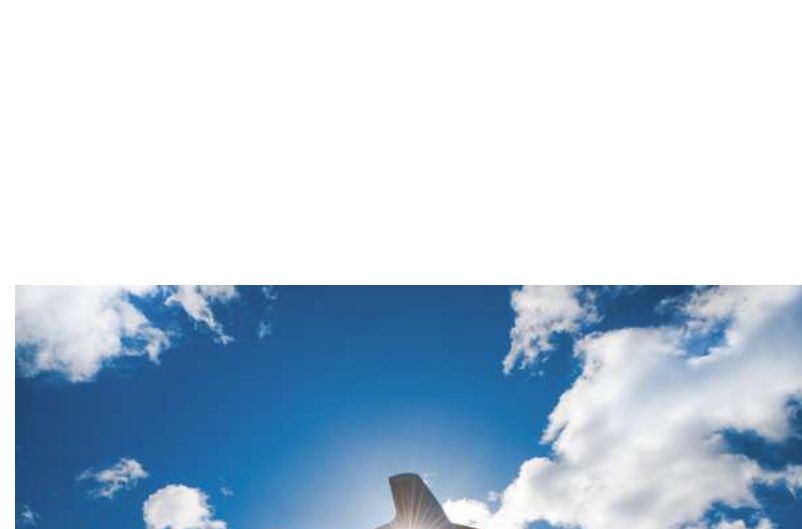

A breakthrough for green energy in Lithuania

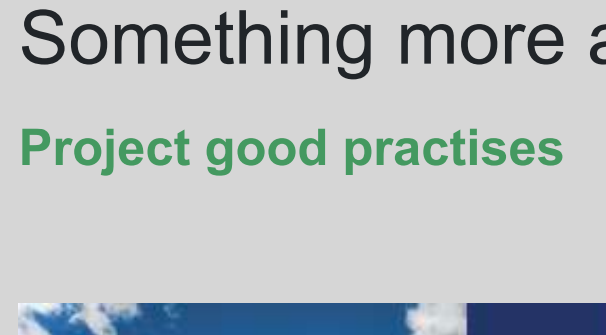

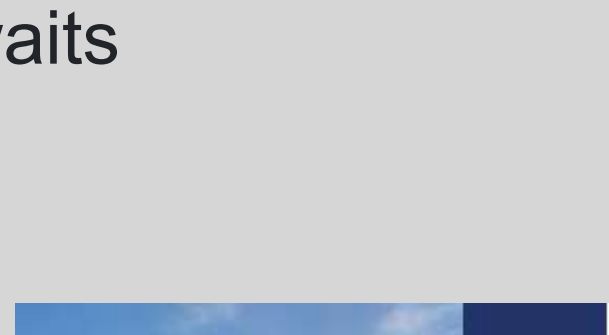

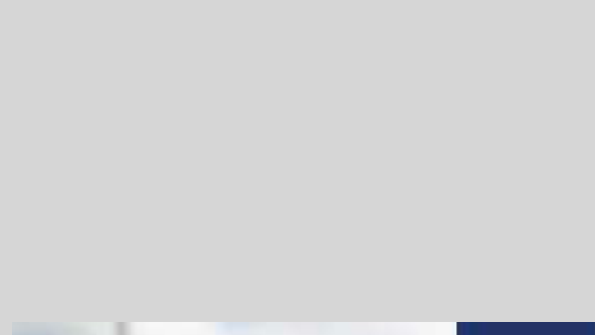
State support for the solar park in 2022
