## Minutes of meeting

The sixth meeting brought together key stakeholders from policy decision makers and those involved in the deployment and development of charging infrastructure for electric vehicles, as well as those involved in the EV dealership and incentive procedures. The opportunity was taken to familiarize the participants with the current phase of EMOBICITY project implementation, but also to provide an opportunity to exchange the latest experiences in the development of emobility in the Republic of Croatia with an emphasis on the recent implementation of incentives for the purchase of EVs.

**Bruno Židov** (Energy Institute Hrvoje Požar) gave a welcome speech and presented the activities in the field of e-mobility that are underway and planned in the Republic of Croatia. He presented the progress so far and the achievements achieved within the EMOBICITY project.

**Tomislav Čop** (Energy Institute Hrvoje Požar) presented the most interesting findings of the EIHP study which deals with the issue of the future introduction of the emissions trading system (ETS) in the transport sector. In this context, the scenario of the development of the vehicle fleet in the Republic of Croatia until the year 2050 was presented, and the consequent consumption of electricity as well as peak loads were presented. In the following, **Robert Fabek** (Energy Institute Hrvoje Požar, online via the MS Teams platform) presented the



economic and financial implications of the presented scenario with the introduction of the ETS system in the transport sector.

After introducing presentations, **Tomislav Čop** (Energy Institute Hrvoje Požar) moderated an interesting conversation and knowledge exchange of all present stakeholders.

**Igor Ban** (Kempower) commented on the vehicle fleet development scenario presented by EIHP. He stated that he believes that the proportion of hydrogen-powered vehicles in the category of heavy freight transport is overestimated. He explained the technological solutions that already exist on the market and are at a high stage of development, which enable electric vehicles to be charged with extremely high power. He claims that this will enable electric vehicles to be used competitively in heavy freight transport as well as long distance buses.

**Maja Rajčić** (FZOEU) comes from the organization that is responsible for implementing the incentive policy to develop mobility in Croatia. She acquainted all attendees with the experiences and feedback regarding the Public Call for EV purchase co-financing that was carried out during the June 2022. She stated that this time the interest of the users was extremely high and that from the technical side the Call was conducted properly and without difficulties.

**Mario Mamić** (Grand auto) explained his role as an EV dealer in the entire process of applying for co-financing for the purchase of an electric vehicle. Namely, car dealers are responsible for fulfilling requests for incentives on behalf of the customer. Car dealers send this request via the online platform to the EPEEF. Mario stated that the fact that the application option was open for less than two minutes was very challenging.

As a key conclusion of the discussion, it can be stated that a certain agreement was reached between all those present that it is desirable to revise the system of encouraging the purchase of electric vehicles implemented by EPEEF, especially regarding the amount of the incentive itself, which is currently very high.

The thematic conversation and networking continued with a light snack and refreshment.

All stakeholders expressed a strong desire to continue to be informed about the further implementation of the EMOBICITY project and to be informed about the findings from the monitoring phase of the project.


