

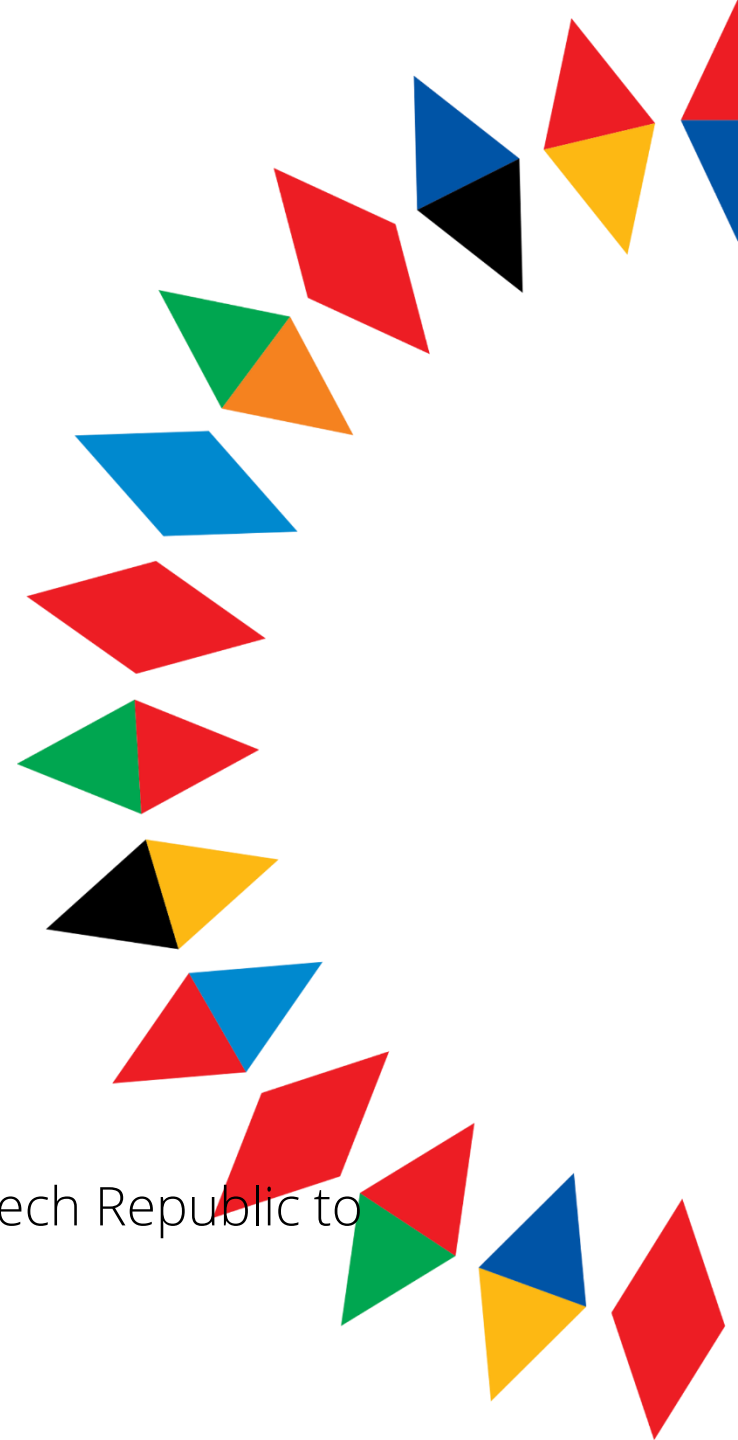

- Technology Infrastructures as part of the infrastructures ecosystem, mapping users' needs

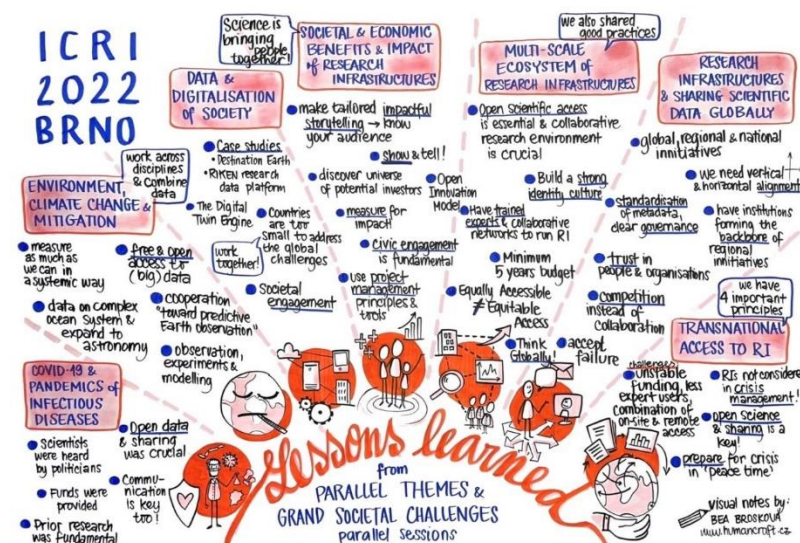


Brno Declaration
