

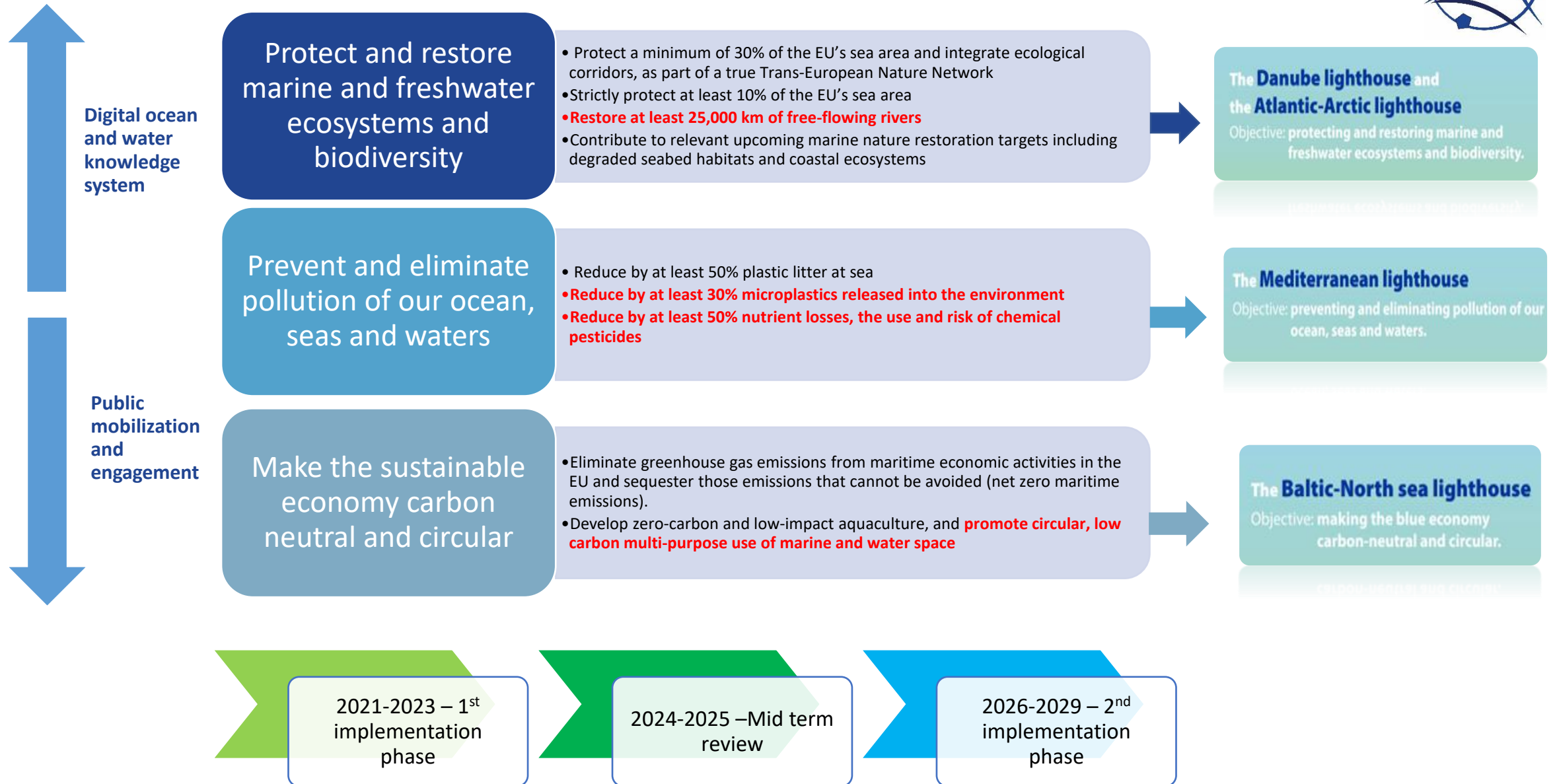

The involvement of the CPMR in the Mission Ocean and Waters



- ▶▶▶ Facilitate a successful first phase (2022-2025) of the Mission Ocean & Waters
- ▶▶▶ Prepare the ground for inspiring and engaging citizens and stakeholders



The CPMR will:



Support a study on regional S3 to provide key recommendations on the use of funding mechanisms and foster the development of joint demonstration projects



Contribute to the development an impactful stakeholder engagement model by piloting four stakeholder assemblies in each lighthouse

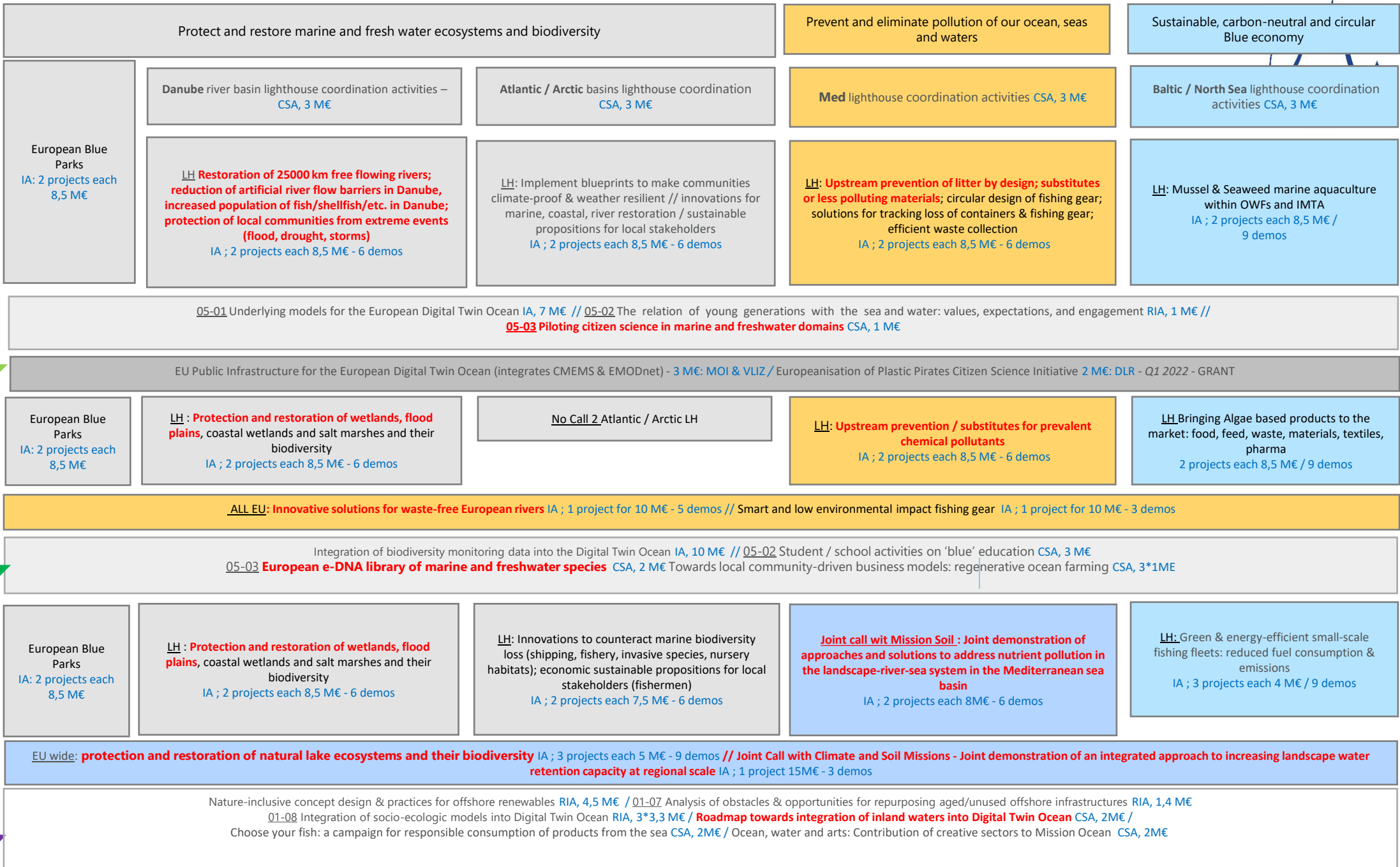

Mission Ocean Charter



What is it?

-  A non-binding instrument open to any public or private interested parties
-  A way for all stakeholders to express their commitments to reach the Mission objectives
-  An inclusive and inspirational framework to galvanize cooperation, collaboration, resources and activities to reach the Mission goal



Mission Charter Platform

To endorse the Charter, stakeholders need to submit an action through the Charter online platform, indicating how they will collaborate and mobilise their resources to achieve the Mission objectives.

When adhering to the Charter, stakeholders will have access to the services and tools of the Mission Ocean and be involved in various events, fostering networking and potential collaborations
