




#### Interregional cooperation **projects** 2014 – 2020

#### **Results** achieved\* by projects







- Focus on **exchange of experience**




Different from crossborder or transnational cooperation



5 April to 31 May 2022

#### 134 proposals submitted **72 projects approved**





#### First call - first lessons learned

- At least one Investment for jobs & growth goal programme
- Description of the **policy instrument addressed**

• **Innovative character** (Interreg Europe cannot finance follow up projects)

 Geographical coverage beyond transnational cooperation areas (e.g., MED covers Slovenia, Bulgaria and part of France)


