

Centru Region: 6 counties, 34.100 sqkm; Population: 2.63 Million inhab.(2020) Urbanization rate: 57.4% Ethnic and linguistic diversity: Romanians (61.2%),

Hungarians(28.6%), Roma (4.7%), Germans (0.4%)

G.D.P./capita: 20500 euro as of 2019; 3rd rank in the national hierarchy (66% of EU average)

Unemployment rate: 3.3% (as of December 2020)





- 57 Local Administrative Units out of which 20 have the rank of "Municipality"
 - 1 Municipality has more than 200.000 inhabitants
 - 2 Municipalities have between 100.000 200.000 inhab.
 - 3 Municipalities have between 50.000 -100 000 inhab.,
 - 7 cities have between 30 000 50.000 inhab.
 - 18 towns have between 10 000 -30 000 residents, while other 26 small cities have less than 10 000 inhab.




- Currently in Centru Region there are two Metropolitan Areas: Braşov and Tîrgu Mureş

Territorial bodies for regional development (1)

Regional Development Board Centru (RDB)

Role	 Decision making body without legal status; It was established and it works based on partnership principle
Main tasks	 Verifies and approves the Regional Development Plan; Approves the financial allocation for the regional development; Coordinates the RDA Centru's activities; Endorses the agreements on regional development concluded between RDA Centru and other Parts
Structure	24 members - 4 seats for each county of the region



COOPERATION WITH INTERNATIONAL PARTNERS


- Cooperation is a key element in Centru Region.
