









Obstacles for SMEs digital transformation in LATVIA



 Information fragmentation on digitalization opportunities (various tools and activities are not coordinated)

 SMEs have a low level of knowledge in digital skills, which hinders successful implementation of digital transformation in SMEs.

 SMEs lack of general knowledge and understanding about the opportunities and benefits of digital transformation.

Actions to strengthen digital transformation of SMEs in LATVIA



Complementing a one-stop platform towards SMEs digital transformation - portal www.business.gov.lv.

The aim is to reach 70 000 unique visitors who visited portal by 31.07.2023

Lessons Learned: Followed by good practises of **Portugal** (Industry 4.0 initiative Financing Portal) and **Austria** (Digital Austria)

Actions to strengthen digital transformation of SMEs in LATVIA



Creation of knowledge bank as part of the platform www.business.gov.lv – information and learning materials available for SMEs to develop digital business features.

The aim is to reach 3000 unique visitors who visited Knowledge bank by 31.07.2023.

Actions to strengthen digital transformation of SMEs in LATVIA



SME Digital Maturity Test to provide individual consultations and trainings.

The aim is that by 31.07.2023. SMEs who completed Digital maturity test followed by individual consultation will reach 200.

Lessons Learned: Followed by good practises of **Portugal** (Industry 4.0 initiative) and **Spain** (Digital Advisors and Ticcamaras program).
