### Action b.i.1. Support for renovation and refurbishment interventions for the energy efficiency of public structures and systems

"the use of construction techniques and materials or components that, in their life cycle, ensure the minimization of environmental impacts and CO<sub>2</sub> emissions."







#### Action 2 - More sustainable energy efficiency

#### A more mature use of LC methodologies

Rewarding projects proposing the use of product with LC-based certifications and/or with better environmental performance than requested by applicable regulations and standards – e.g. CAM – minimum environmental criteria)

#### Proposing simplified methods of applying LC approach

On some components, for some typologies of buildings, recalling existing methods or protocols, etc.).
