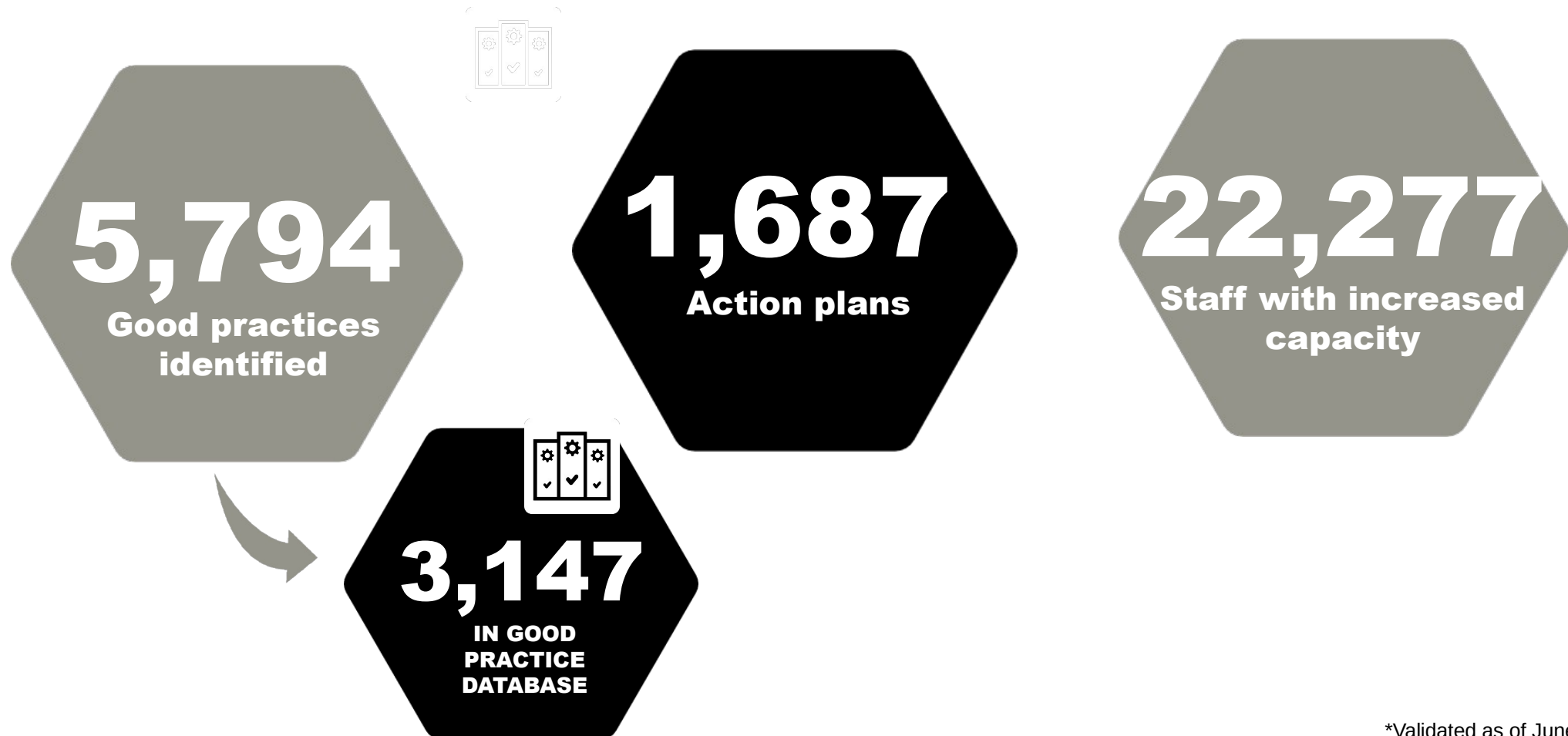

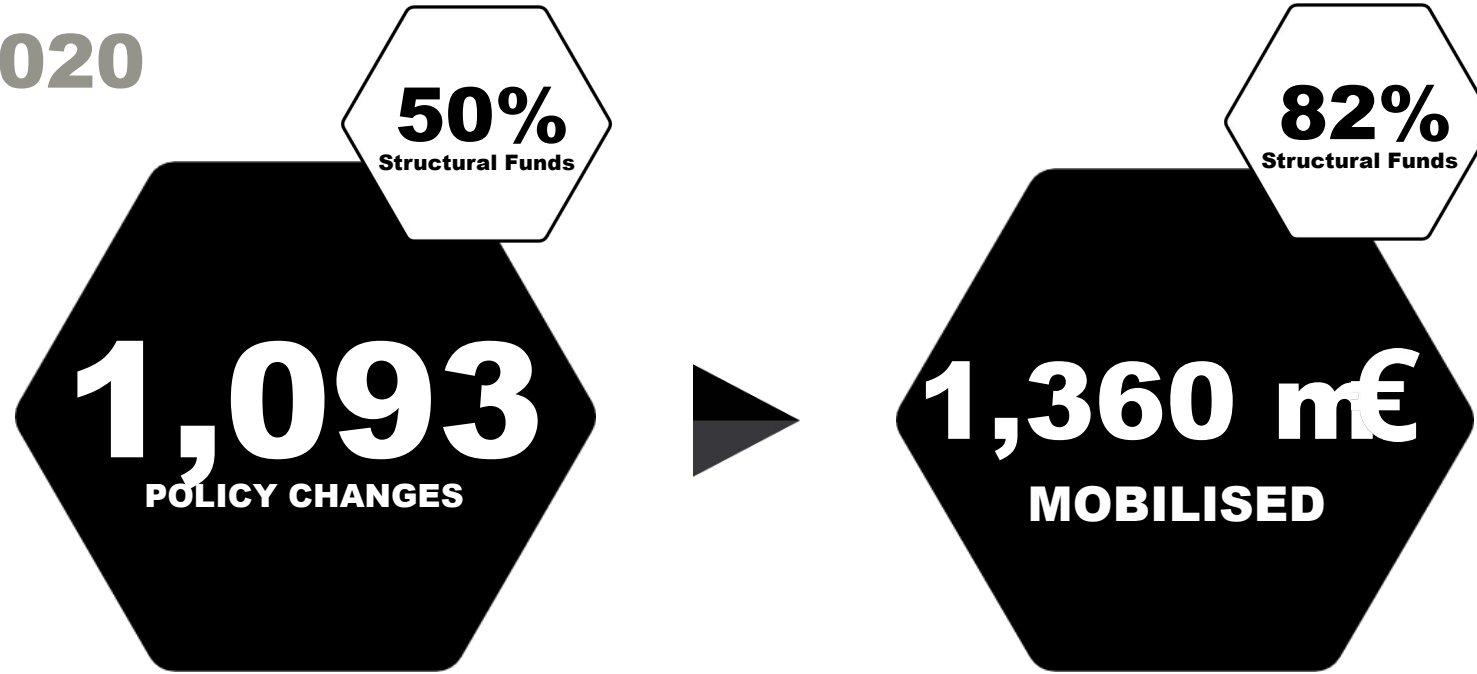

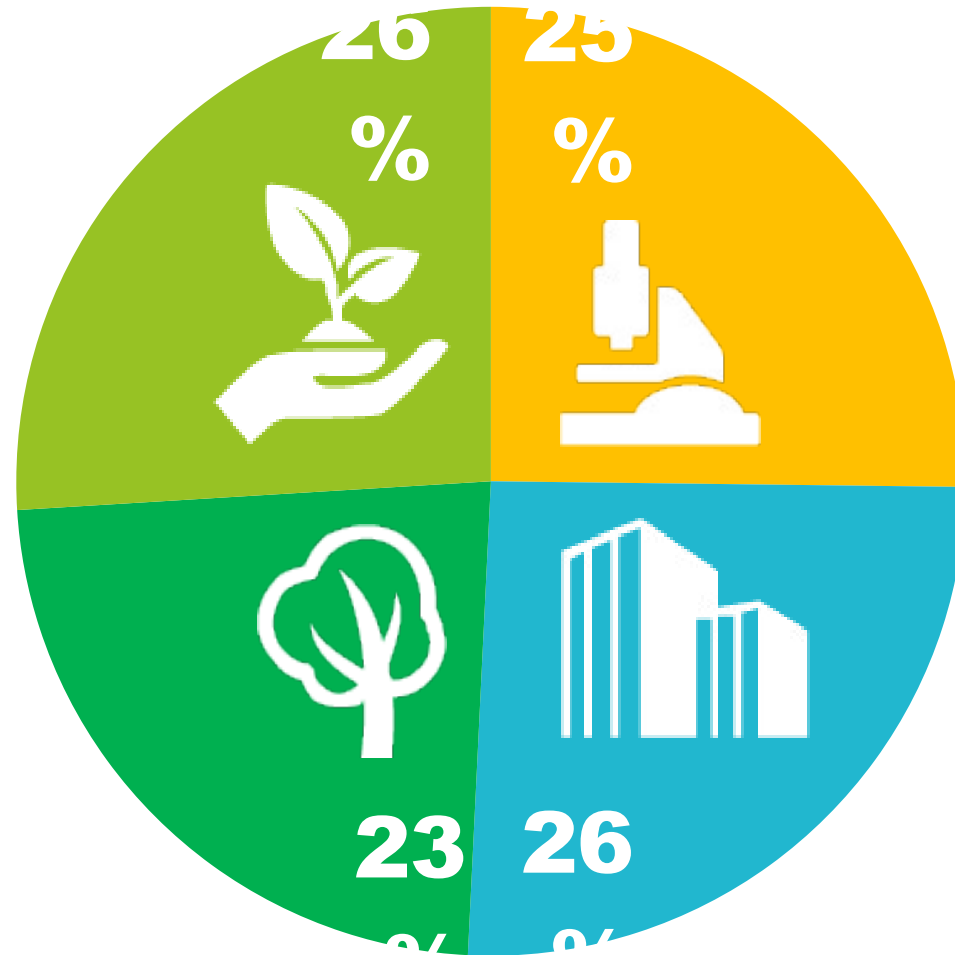

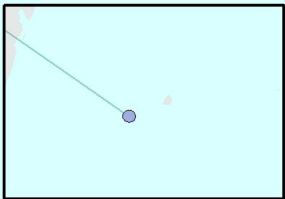

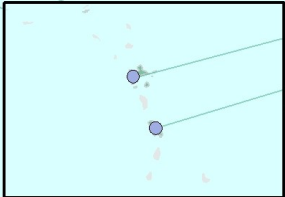

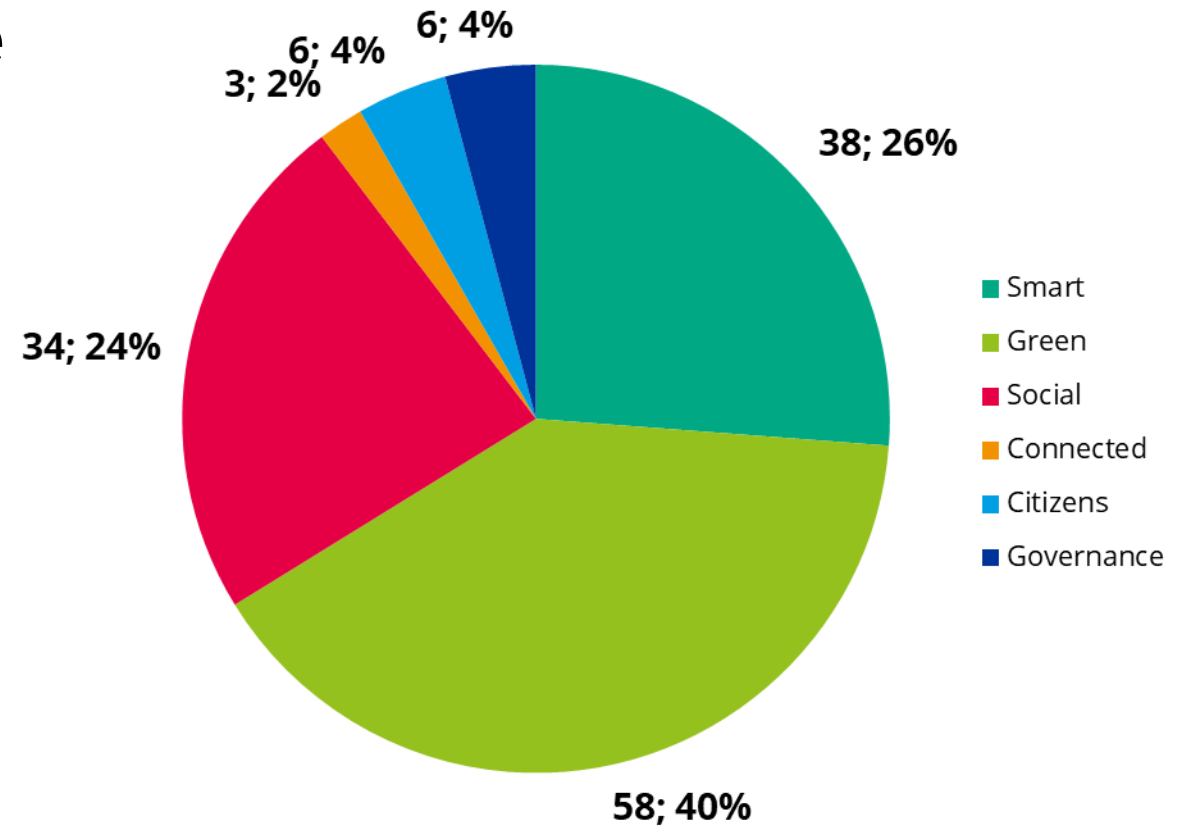
- Open from 5 April to 31 May 2022
